

CITY OF LOS ANGELES WESTSIDE PLANNING INITIATIVES



The City of Los Angeles is working on three projects designed to enhance a variety of transportation and planning conditions on the Westside including the following projects:

MOBILITY ELEMENT (MOBILITY PLAN 2035)

Description: The City recently updated the Transportation Element of the City's General Plan, referred to as Mobility Plan 2035 or MP 2035, to reflect policies and programs that will lay the policy foundation for safe, accessible, and enjoyable streets for pedestrians, bicyclists, transit users, and vehicles throughout the City of Los Angeles, including the Westside. The Plan incorporates "complete streets" principles, includes new citywide street standards and new street networks creating enhancements for all road users, and offers guidance in allocating often scarce resources when determining future mobility improvements.

Council District: All

Project Status: Adopted by City Council in Winter 2015.

WESTSIDE MOBILITY PLAN

Description: In coordination with LADOT, develop recommendations to improve the connectivity of the transit network, better serve all modes of transportation, improve the efficiency of the transportation system, and enhance the livability of the major boulevards in Westside communities. Includes updates to development fees and the lists of transportation improvements associated with the Coastal Transportation Corridor Specific Plan and West LA Transportation Improvement and Mitigation Plan Specific Plan.

Council District: 5, 11

Project Status: Preparation of four Mobility Improvement Packages with key performance metrics, EIR scoping meetings and community workshops are completed. Release of Draft Specific Plan updates and Draft EIR in January 2016.

Upcoming Milestone: Public meetings in January and February 2016. The public comment period for the CTCSP/WLA TIMP Draft Environmental Impact Report begins January 7, 2016 and ends 60 days later on March 7, 2016.

EXPO CORRIDOR TRANSIT NEIGHBORHOOD PLAN

Description: With grant funding from Metro, preparation of a new Specific Plan for five station areas along the Expo Line (Phase II) in West Los Angeles and Palms, addressing new development regulations that better support transit ridership, creating more pedestrian-oriented design including streetscape plans, and improving the configuration and condition of streets.

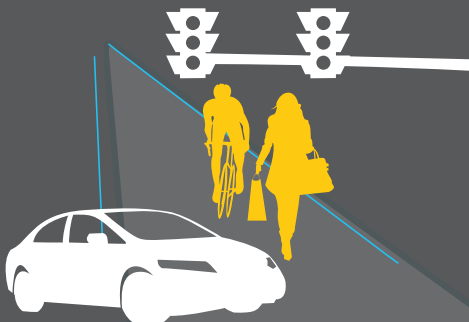
Council District: 5, 10, 11

Project Status: Two rounds of public workshops completed in late 2012 and mid-2013, with preliminary plan recommendations. Draft Plan is currently available.

Upcoming Milestone: Release of Draft EIR Summer 2016.
